



OUR RECOMMENDED VIP (VOTER INTTEGRITY FOR THE PEOPLE) VOTING SYSTEM

- **Return to precinct voting as specified in the TN Constitution vs. voting in vote centers.**
 - This meets Art. IV Sec. 1 while removing the internet connections between all voting locations.
 - Vote centers also violate TCA 2-20-101 as scanners currently in vote centers aren't precinct-based.
 - Vote centers violate the equal protection clause of the 14th amendment of the US Constitution, as well as Article I Sec. 5 of the Tennessee Constitution stating that elections must be free and equal.
 - Lock voter rolls and move registration totally offline during early/election day voting.
- **Clean up the voter rolls that have been proven to be dirty with moved, dead and phantom voters.**
 - Rolls loaded with illegal voters are an easy source of nefarious activity.
- **Remove hackable, secretive, voting computers that have been proven to be vulnerable.**
 - BMDs, tabulators, registration, election mgt. system. Other states have implemented this.
 - Many experts have researched this solution and affirm it greatly reduces risk in our election.
 - Ballot marking devices are especially vulnerable and don't print out the entire ballot for verification.
 - You can't purchase enough BMDs to accommodate an unpredictable crowd flow seen in vote centers.
 - Any remaining electronic equipment **MUST** be updated to current security standards and checked via a Security Risk Assessment using cyber security experts prior to an election.
- **Move to high-security, currency-grade, random-numbered, hand-marked paper ballots.**
 - Transfer the technology from the machines into the paper.
 - With this move, we then will have a voter-verifiable paper audit trail which we don't have now.
 - With a randomized numbered ballot, citizens can track their ballot through the process.
- **Count ballots by hand in precincts at close of elections. It can be done.**
 - Election day counting in precincts immediately following the close of the election.
 - Absentee/early voting counted at another location and both completed by end of voting day.
 - Will require legislative work to facilitate the counting by hand. In process now.
- **Post all ballot images (which contain no voter identification), poll official reports, precinct videos on-line day after election for additional transparency.**
 - Enable "The People's Audit." Citizens can work through the online documents to conduct their own audit.
- **Institute stronger audits of every race that look at all aspects of the election, the voter rolls, the machines, the process, the results.**
 - The current audit is merely a hand re-count of a few select races. Do them all!
- **Live stream all voting/counting with appropriately placed video cameras.**
 - To ensure election transparency, which can return citizen confidence in the voting process.
- **No vendor allowed to do all -- generate, scan, count, compile ballots. Diversification is a must.**
- **ACCURACY is more important than CONVENIENCE.**
