WE'RE ADVOCATES FOR:

- SECURITY and ACCURACY are more important than CONVENIENCE!
- Return to precinct voting. Never let commissions implement problematic voting centers.
- Clean up voter rolls at least 60 days before EVERY election.
- Lock voter rolls and move registration process totally offline during early/election day voting.
- Remove hackable voting computers – Scanners, tabulators, BMDs, DREs, Election Management System.
- Return to hand-marked paper ballots -- High-security, currency-grade, watermarked paper with randomized numbers for citizens to track their ballot. Move the technology from the machines to the ballots and new processes.
- Optimum: Count ballots by hand in precincts immediately post-election. Interim: Optical scanners/tabulators with sufficient guardrails.
- Return registration to all paper and remove all internet connections that come into a precinct.
- If electronic voting equipment must stay, then it MUST be updated to current security standards and checked via a Security Risk Audit using citizen/security/IT experts... before it can be used in an election.
- Voter photo ID and other registration security steps are not voter suppression!
- No single vendor can register, generate, scan, count and compile ballots. Process diversification is a must.
- Videotape/live stream the casting and counting of ballots in ways supporting voter privacy.
- Post ballots/key poll officer reports online the day after an election for public access: The People's Audit.
- Return to election day versus election season voting.

ACTION:

First:

- Build relationships with your **local Election Commission, State Representatives and Senators**.
 - Search your county election commission website to learn who they are.

Second:

- Write, call, email and meet with them to let them know your concerns, insist on a response.
- Advocate for your issues in a professional manner. The issues on this website might help you.
- Talking points IN YOUR OWN WORDS:
 - We all want open, transparent elections but we're extremely concerned with what we've seen in previous elections in Tennessee and across the country.
 - Machines are vulnerable; hand-marked paper ballots are safer than ballot marking devices; return (or keep) us voting in precinct rather than susceptible vote centers; drastically improve election audits; implement serious punishment for election crimes.
 - Listen closely to citizens -- your constituents -- who know far more about elections and election processes than you think.

Third:

- **Get involved:** Be a Poll Worker, Precinct Chair, Poll Watcher (Email: tn.pwatch@protonmail.com)
- **Go to meetings:** Learn what system they use/what they want to use/read past minutes.
