## **Williamson County Election Commission**

The WCEC held a short meeting today.

- Several citizens made comments.
  - o Frank Limpus with Tennessee Voters for Election Integrity asked the WCEC for answers to 18 questions concerning missing machine seals, tab numbers that didn't correspond with the seal numbers on the technicians' report that documents numbers when they set up the machines for the March 5<sup>th</sup> election, protected counts that changed without explanations, sixty-six votes that somehow made it into the election but not on the documentation, a number of examples of poor math that were approved by a number of poll officials, and one tabulator whose postelection serial number dramatically changed from the serial number on the tabulator that was set up pre-election by the technicians. If interested, here is the report that was presented to the WCEC Chairman and Election Administrator on June 7<sup>th</sup> documenting these issues. Not wanting to address the questions that had been presented to him nine weeks ago, Chairman Jonathan Duda flippantly said all of the issues were human error. Frank wonders how many human errors are allowed per election?
  - Two citizens discussed a situation from the August 1<sup>st</sup> election where a citizen was turned away from voting by a poll official because she was wearing a shirt that said: "Loves Jesus and America too." The poll official claimed it was "political campaigning." Both citizens commented that Jesus wasn't running for anything and asked why this occurred and what sort of training is given that would make this poll official turn the voter away. Chairman Duda admitted the WCEC made a mistake and that he called the voter to apologize that this occurred. He said they would do a better job training workers on this. (The voter did turn her shirt inside out and came back to vote the first day of early voting.)
- Commission Chairman Jonathan Duda reminded citizens of the county's "textmygov" text channel that can be accessed for voting updates and notifications.
- He also said that the WCEC had approximately 1,000 new voter registrations.
- The only other agenda item had to do with Senator Marsha Blackburn renting a ballroom at the Cool Spring Conference Center for the November 5<sup>th</sup> election near where the WCEC has a vote center. However, the issue was since handled as the Senator moved her ballroom to another location. So, the issue was moot.

**Next Friday the 16**<sup>th</sup> is the next meeting and here is their <u>agenda</u>. The meeting is at the Election Commission 405 Downs Blvd and starts at 3:00 pm.

### Williamson County School Board
