#### Williamson County School Board

The Policy Committee met on Monday <u>agenda</u> <u>Audio</u> Of the five policies that were discussed, the last two 5.104 and 6.310 were the most interesting. **5.104** applies to hiring practices and follows Title 7 rules and includes:

Williamson County Schools provides equal employment opportunities to all employees and applicants for employment and prohibits discrimination and harassment of any type without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin, disability status, genetic information, pregnancy, protected veteran status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or any other characteristic protected by federal, state or local laws.

**6.310** is the student dress code that follows Title 9. The updated policy uses sex to replace **sexual orientation, and gender identity**. You can listen to the discussion for both starting at 1:02 in the audio.

There are no meetings scheduled for next week.

#### Williamson County Commission

## Williamson County Election Commission

There was a meeting on Friday this week. The regular meeting covered the following:

- The Election Commission's communications strategy
  - They may look into a social media effort but not for the November 2024 election.
  - They will be producing two videos that might be accessible via their website:
    - One to better instruct the Absentee Board members on their duties and expectations;
    - One that is more of a general orientation to working an election and why it is important.
- How they will handle tabulators in the November 2024 election that may exceed their ballot capacity (which is 3,000 ballots).
  - Expectation is that there will be a huge turnout in November; the ES&S tabulators don't have as much storage capacity as the Dominion tabulators did back in 2020.
  - In those vote centers which have proven to have big turnouts, they will add a third tabulator.
  - The IT techs will be authorized to open the ballot storage compartment on tabulators and jostle the ballots to make more room for ballots. They will track this step on special documentation.
  - Poll watchers will need to be aware of this if it happens to ensure they have the new seal/tag number that they can document. This might happen at a time when there are no poll watchers present, so they'll need to ask the poll official if this happened.
- They have scheduled an open house for the public and candidates to check out the voting machines.

The Post-Election (August 1 election) Performance Audit was held following the meeting. (See attached checklist for the audit)

- <u>Tennessee Voters for Election Integrity</u> first recommended this audit process in an October 2021 presentation to the Tennessee State Election Commission. Nice to see three years later their recommendation was enacted.
- Purpose: To ensure that the county commission is performing its election duties effectively.
- Took about 1.5 hours to check itself against the Performance Audit checklist (see attached).

- Bob Brown, who used to be chairman of the WCEC, now heads this process for the state.
- Three counties out of the 95 Tennessee counties are randomly chosen each election to undergo the performance audit each year. Williamson County was the first such county.
- When it was completed, the audit was approved by the WCEC, even though several items on the checklist were not completed by the commission. Not sure why it could be approved given unfinished items on the checklist.
