

Williamson County School Board

The Policy Committee met on Monday agenda audio;

The meeting went on for almost two hours, approximately half on the attendance policy and half on the library policy. Most of the discussion on the library policy centered around the "decision tree". I have copied it below.



As you can see, it is very convoluted. There are eight questions and the place to start is with question one at the lower left "Does the challenged material..." and then move from there to other questions like the lower right-hand question "Does the challenged material have any other artistic, historical or literary merit?". Now that's a good one. By following this tree, one can imagine almost any book could pass muster based on one's moral convictions.

Next week, the board will hold its **monthly work** session on Thursday the 11th at 6:00 pm. The PD Center building is located at 1761 West Main Street, Franklin. <u>agenda online streaming</u> (click on April 11, 2024 school board work session livestream at 6:00 pm on the 11th)

One item on the agenda is a request for capital improvements totaling \$24,000,000 that must be approved by both the school board and the county commission. These work sessions are enlightening, and I highly recommend that you either attend or watch them online.
