Williamson County Election Commission

Early voting ended yesterday and 61.3% or 121,585 of the 198,288 registered voters in the county voted early. I am told that this is a record for the number of early voters but not the percentage of voters. Below is how the county and each district voted. Of the 198,288 voters, approximately 20,000 are inactive which means that there are only 178,000 or so actual voters. So, on election day, there will only be approximately 56,000 more votes.

Williamson County Commission

The only meeting this week was the **Education Committee which met on Monday**. There were two resolutions that were approved and will be on the agenda for the full commission meeting on November 12th. The **first** was a resolution to amend the school district's general budget by \$1,461,000 to purchase six new general-purpose school buses and six special needs school buses. The **second** was a resolution to properly distribute the \$16,781,543 approved for pay raises across the board. **I am attaching** both resolutions, the distribution spreadsheet, the meeting's agenda and the minutes from the April 29th meeting.

Next week, there are several important meetings. On **Monday the 4**th, **the Budget committee** will be meeting at 4:30 in the Executive Conference room in the Williamson County Administration Complex at 1320 W. Main St. This meeting will be recorded, and you can call the office of Budgeting and Purchase to request a packet of info for the meeting (615) 790-5868.

On **Monday the 4th, the Tax Study Committee** will be meeting at 5:30 pm in the mayor's conference room in the Williamson County Administration Complex at 1320 W. Main St. This committee is not recorded and there is no published agenda.

On **Tuesday, election day, the Rules Committee** will be meeting at 5:30 pm in the Executive Conference room in the Williamson County Administration Complex at 1320 W. Main St. This committee is not recorded and there is no published agenda. This is an important meeting, and I encourage people to attend.
