**Williamson County Election Commission**

Early voting ended yesterday and 61.3% or 121,585 of the 198,288 registered voters in the county voted early. I am told that this is a record for the number of early voters but not the percentage of voters. Below is how the county and each district voted. Of the 198,288 voters, approximately 20,000 are inactive which means that there are only 178,000 or so actual voters. So, on election day, there will only be approximately 56,000 more votes.

REMINDER: All voters must present a Federal or State of Tennessee identification bearing the voters' name and photo unless excluded under certain provisions of the law when casting a ballot. T.C.A. §2-7-112 (a)).

REMINDER: Voters who have not updated their voter registration with any change of name/address must follow fail-safe procedures and may experience a delay in voting. (T.C.A. § 2-7-140)

The location of the Absentee Counting Board will be at the Election Commission Office located at 405 Downs Blvd in Franklin, which will convene at 6:45 a.m. prevailing time.

Pursuant to T.C.A. § 2-6-304 (e), Notice is hereby given to all political parties and candidates appearing on the ballot, that the vote totals will be removed from the early voting machines during the duties performed by the Absentee Counting Board.

### **Williamson County School Board**

### **Williamson County Commission**

The only meeting this week was the **Education Committee which met on Monday**. There were two resolutions that were approved and will be on the agenda for the full commission meeting on November 12<sup>th</sup>. The **first** was a resolution to amend the school district's general budget by \$1,461,000 to purchase six new general-purpose school buses and six special needs school buses. The **second** was a resolution to properly distribute the \$16,781,543 approved for pay raises across the board. **I am attaching** both resolutions, the distribution spreadsheet, the meeting's agenda and the minutes from the April 29<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Next week, there are several important meetings. On **Monday the 4<sup>th</sup>, the Budget committee** will be meeting at 4:30 in the Executive Conference room in the Williamson County Administration Complex at 1320 W.
