KEY: Highlighted numbers represent highest voter turnout year in the county. In most cases, voter turnout has *decreased* after all initial implementations of vote centers, even though in most cases the voting population has increased. In three of these five target counties, highest turnout has occurred under precincts, not vote centers. After an initial year in vote centers, Rutherford County’s turnout numbers have decreased. It wasn’t until the third year in vote centers that Monroe County’s voter turnout experienced an up year. Other counties approved for vote centers, but have yet to implement them, include Hamblen and Washington counties. Mostly because of the financial hardship.

Current vote center users: Rutherford (193,337 voters), Williamson (169,748), Wilson (96,936), Monroe (31,783), Henry (19,514) and Weakley (16,912). Together they comprise 528,257 active registered voters, 11% of active Tennessee registered voters (4,830,000) per the Tennessee Secretary of State.
